***All families are asked to please send in TWO CONTAINERS of disinfectant wipes at the beginning of the school year.**

3-Year-Old Preschool

- One container of hand/face wipes
- One box of tissues
- Bath towel or mat for rest time in a reusable shopping bag
- Change of clothes in a large Ziploc bag identified with name

4-Year-Old Preschool

- One container of hand/face wipes
- One box of tissues
- Bath towel or mat for rest time in a reusable shopping bag
- Book bag
- One pocket folder
- Plastic safety scissors (optional)
- Crayons 8-12 count (optional)
- Glue stick (optional)
- Markers (optional)
- Pencil box (optional/ will be used for optional items)

Kindergarten

- One box of tissues
- One 15-count box of gallon Ziploc bags
- One 20-count box of quart or sandwich Ziploc bags
- Bath towel or mat for rest time (should fit in 4.5" x 12" space when rolled)
- Book bag
- Two pocket folders (1 green, 1 red)
- Plastic safety scissors (optional)
- Crayons (optional)
- Glue stick (optional)
- Markers (optional)

First Grade

- Two boxes of tissues in August and another one in January
- Pencil box
- Two heavy pocket folders (1 red, 1 green)
- Two heavy pocket folders (to use as barriers on desk)
- Scissors
- Twenty Ticonderoga Pencils
- One pack of forty pencil top erasers
- Large pencil eraser
- Two boxes of 16-count crayons (one will be kept for January)
- Four glue sticks
- Math money (2 quarters, 10 dimes, 5 nickels, 20 pennies in a plastic container with a lid. Please have the student's name on the container.)
- Paint shirt with name on it

Note: No trappers, ring binders, markers

Second Grade

- Box of tissues (200-250)
- Pencil bag or box
- Eight #2 pencils
- Unopened box of pencil top erasers (to be used later in the year)
- Crayons (24 box)
- Four glue sticks
- Scissors with name on them
- One dry-erase marker
- One orange folder for Technology
- Two plastic or vinyl folders

Third Grade

- 1 Folder specifically for math class- Homework Folder (will carry as necessary)
- Two packs of lined index cards
- One 3-pack of blue or black (Expo Brand) dry erase markers (will be left in and used in the classroom)
- Flashcards – addition, subtraction multiplication and division to **keep at home** for practice

Language Arts

- Four pocket folders (one for math)
- Crayons (24 box)
- Five #2 pencils with erasers
- 3 Glue sticks
- 2 Bottles of glue
- Three boxes of tissues

Upper Elementary (Grades 4 and 5)

Math

- Durable 2” clear cover binder (will stay in the classroom/taken home by student as individually needed)
- 1 Folder specifically for math class- Homework Folder (will be in binder/zippered trapper that will travel with them)
- One 3-pack of blue or black (Expo Brand) dry erase markers (will be left in and used in the classroom)
- Flashcards – addition, subtraction multiplication and division to **keep at home** for practice

Language Arts
