Absences/Excuses

Dismissal Changes

All dismissal changes from your child's regular routine must be submitted in writing to office@jcsfamily.org. Please try to have dismissal changes to the office before 1:30 p.m.

Staying After School

ALL students who are staying after school must submit a written note to their teacher/coach (or emailed to the school office). The note should state the teacher/coach supervising your child. Teacher supervision must be confirmed before your student may stay. Student athletes do NOT need a written note—they just report directly to practice.
