## 2025-2026 Supply List

All students will need a water bottle with a non-spill lid for everyday

### **3-Year-Old PK**

- 3-Year-Old PK
- Book bag
- Pack of large or jumbo crayons
- One container of hand/face wipes
- Self-contained mat or small blanket in reusable bag for rest time (full day only)
- Change of clothes in a large Ziploc bag identified with name (kept in backpack)

### **4-Year-Old PK**

- One container of hand/face wipes
- Self-contained mat or small blanket in reusable bag for rest time (full day only)
- Book bag
- Pocket folder
- Pencil box (filled with following items)
  - Safety scissors
  - Crayons 8-12 count
  - Three glue sticks
  - Broadline Markers

### **Kindergarten**

- A bath towel or blanket for rest time (should fit in 4.5" x 12" space when folded/rolled)
- Book bag
- Two pocket folders (1 green with name written on it in permanent marker, 1 red with name and "homework" written on it in permanent marker)
- Safety scissors
- Large pencil eraser
- 2 packs of crayons (no larger than 24 24-pack)
- 8 pack of glue sticks
- 2 packs of markers (broad-line) (10-12 pack)
- 1 package of hand wipes
- Pencil box (with name written on it)
- 1 pack of Play-Doh
- 1 pack of one-gallon ziplock bags
- 1 extra set of "Just In Case Clothes" (in a ziploc bag)

### **Grade 1**

- Plastic Pencil box
- Two heavy-pocket folders (1 red, 1 green)
- Scissors
- Twenty No. 2 pencils
- One pack of pencil-top erasers
- Large pencil eraser
- A four-pack of fine-tip dry erase markers
- Two boxes of 24-count crayons (one will be kept for January)
- Eight glue sticks
- A pack of markers
- A pack of hand wipes

**NOTE: NO PENCIL SHARPENERS OR MECHANICAL PENCILS**

### **Grade 2:**

- Pencil bag or box (bag is preferred)
- Twenty #2 pencils
- One pack of pencil top erasers (to be used later in the year)
- 2 boxes of crayons (24-box) (one held for January)
- Four glue sticks
- Scissors with name on them
- A four-pack of dry-erase markers
- One ORANGE folder for Technology
- Three Folders (One labeled, "HOMEWORK")
- One subject, lined composition notebook (for writer's journal)

**NOTE: NO MARKERS, PENCIL SHARPENERS, MECHANICAL PENCILS, OR PENS**

**Grade 3**

- • Personal pair of kids' scissors
- - *Student's initials written on handle in permanent marker*
- • Pack of red pens
- • One pack of black EXPO Markers
- • One pack of Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- • Two packs of pencil topper erasers
- • One pack of glue sticks
- • One box of Ziploc Bags (Any brand, any size - NO FOLD TOPS)
- • One pack of white 3x5 lined note cards

- 3 thin whiteboard markers
- A "washcloth" to use as a personal whiteboard eraser
- One package of pencil-top erasers
- Two 1-inch 3-ring binders (for reading and Social Studies)

**Grade 5: Social Studies, Math, & Bible**

- One orange pocket folder for technology
- One composition notebook
- Supply of #2 pencils
- Colored pencils-12 colors
- Scissors
- Four small or two large glue sticks (put your name on them)
- Two red pens
- Four dry-erase markers - chisel size, low odor
- One black permanent marker, NOT ultra-fine
- One container of pencil-top erasers
- One large bottle of Elmer's glue, with name on it
- 2 Small zippered pouches, NOT boxes
